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## School

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The School of Arts and College of Design Pablo Picasso in A Coruña is a centre of public education dependent on the Department of Culture, Education and College of the Xunta of Galicia (Consellería de Cultura, Educación e universidade da Xunta de Galicia).

The EASD Pablo Picasso is part of the Confederation of Schools of Art, organization composed of 95 per cent of the public centres of the State providing instruction of Fine Arts and Design.

The current management team of the centre is formed by the director Elena Pardo Antequera, the assistant director Antía Salgado Mesa, the Secretary Irene Gago Pesado and the head of studies José Carlos Barreiro Roca.





## History

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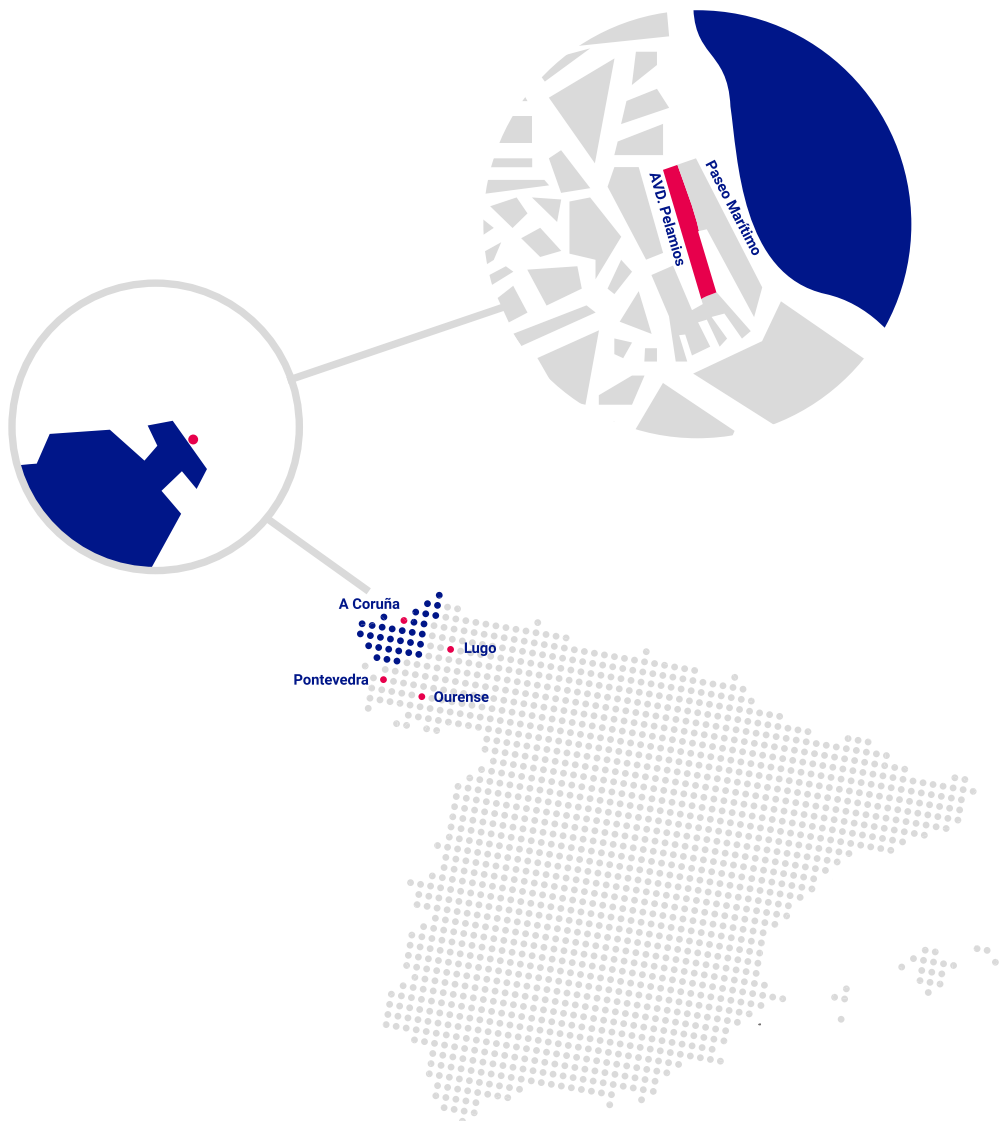
The arts education in A Coruña began with the establishment of the classes of Lineart in the 'School of Navigation' of the Royal Consulate. It would then expand with the Drawing Figure, Drawing of adornment, Modelling and Emptying, Arithmetic and Geometry. In 1850 was formed the so-called "School of Fine Arts" in the House of the Consulate which would move later to the number 23 of "Calle Ancha de San Andrés". This centre will be transformed into the 'College of Arts and Industry'.

It would then occupy the building Eusebio Da Guarda, in the current Pontevedra square, already as "Escuela de Artes Aplicadas y Oficios Artísticos" (School of Applied Arts and Artistic Skills). It stayed there until 1988, when it was eventually moved to a new functional building, in the number two of the street Os Pelamios where it continues nowadays.

Today, School of Art and Superior Design Pablo Picasso in A Coruña is a centre of public education dependent on the Department of Education and Management College of the Xunta of Galicia. It imparts Vocational training degrees in Photography and Illustration and bachelor Degree in Graphic Design and Interior Design.

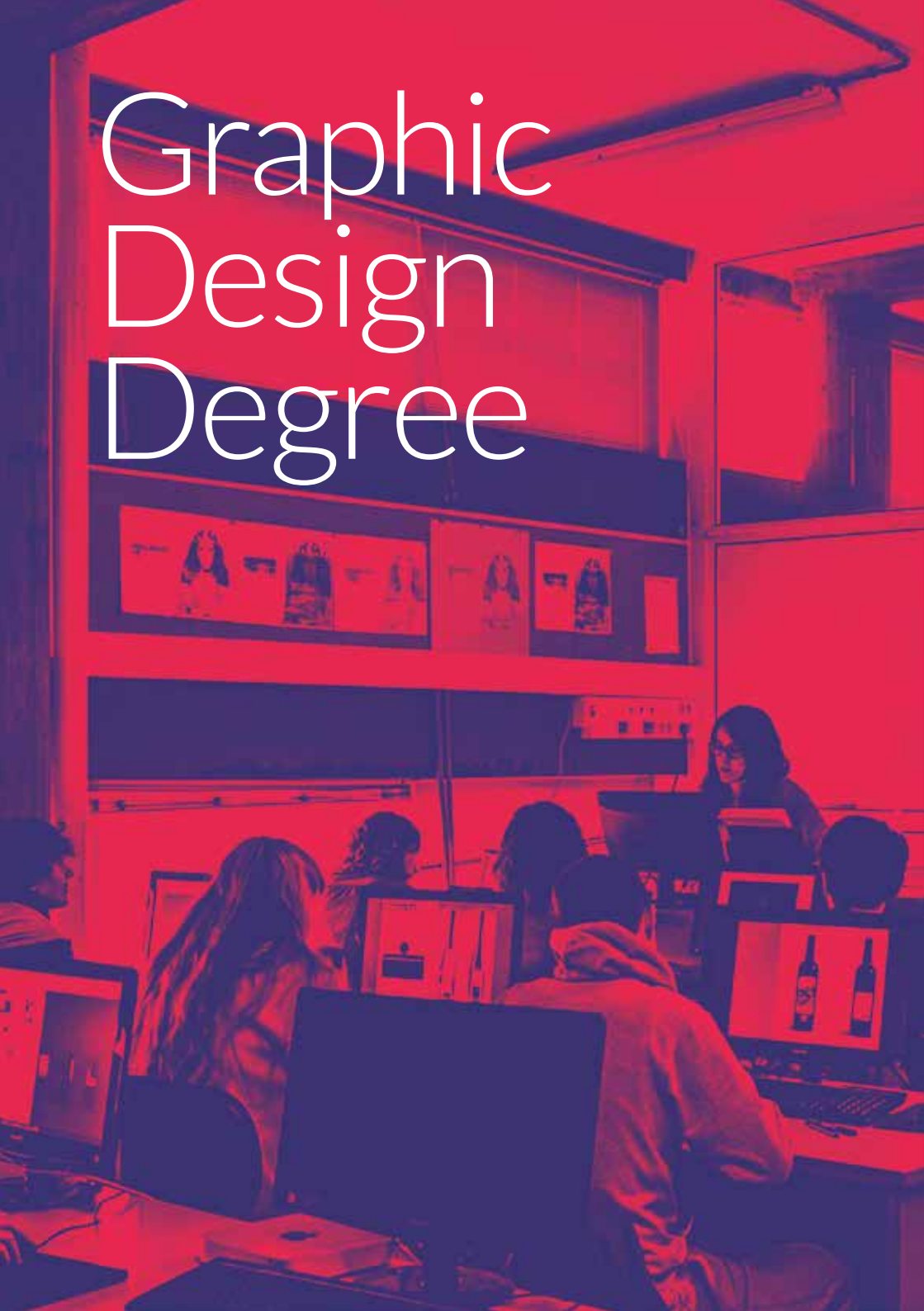

1. The artistic studies in Design will range a basic training and a specific training guided to the preparation to the professional exercise. These studies will develop artistic, scientific and technological capacities.
2. The artistic teachings contain the transversal, general and specific aptitudes and the professional profiles defined in each one of the specialities.
3. This curriculum ranges 4 academic courses with a total of 240 credits ECTS.
4. Each of the courses will have 60 credits ECTS, with an equivalence of 25 hours by credit, and his length will be 38 weeks.

## Registration procedures

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The ORI is in charge of the administration of the Erasmus programme.

The registration procedures for Erasmus students' acceptance will be the following:

- The ORI or the Erasmus coordinator in each foreign institution we have a bilateral agreement signed with, must send us by e-mail the list of their selected Erasmus students as soon as they have completed their selection round at their home university.
- Each selected student will have to complete and send the application form to EASD Pablo Picasso together with a CV, portfolio of works, a provisional learning agreement with the choice of subjects and a motivation letter (written in spanish or english).

The applications should arrive at EASD Pablo Picasso before May 31st. If the chosen period of stay is the second semester in the home institution, then the deadline would be November 30th.

The applications should be sent by e-mail to the ORI Coordinator.

Within four weeks, students would receive the confirmation of their acceptance/refusal as a student at the EASD Pablo Picasso.

All foreign Erasmus students should, at their arrival at A Coruña, first come to our office to fulfill their enrolment. They all should bring along the following documents from their country of origin:

- One ID size colour photographs with white background.
- Medical insurance coverage valid in Spain (European Health Card) or private insurance.
- Copy of ID or passport.
- Final study plan proposal approved by their home coordinators (Learning Agreement).



## Teaching language

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The official teaching language is Spanish, and the minimum level required is B1 Spanish.

Official Language School of A Coruña - Escola Oficial de Idiomas da Coruña, EOI - offers courses to foreign students who need to improve their linguistic knowledge; they can register at the EOI at their arrival at A Coruña. At the end of the course, they will receive an official certificate according to their level of Spanish language.

## Description of the institutional grading system

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The qualifications of notes in the EASD Pablo Picasso are conducted in a scale from 0 to 10, and it is comparable to the ECTS grading system (A-E).

# General Practical Information. Host country formalities

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## Police

All foreign students staying more than 3 months in A Coruña are recommended to pass by the Police Department to obtain a Residence Permit. This will facilitate their stay in the country and will allow them to open bank accounts, buy the "Millenium Card" for reduced bus tickets, look for temporary jobs, etc.

In order to obtain the Residence Permit, students will have to first obtain the Certificate of the Census, following the steps listed below:

After the students have found an apartment in A Coruña, they should go to City Hall or to the Forum Metropolitano where they have to register in the Census of A Coruña. Documentation needed:

- Passport or National Identity Card.
- Fill out the documents given to them at City Hall.
- Show one of the following documents:
  - Renting Contract.
  - Electric or water bill on his/her name.

If the student shares an apartment with other student who has been registered in the census, the new student can register with him/her, as long as the student authorizes the new student, filling out the City Hall document for the effect.

If the student does not have any of the documents mentioned above, and all these documents are in the name of the apartment's owner, the students can register in the census, with the authorization of the apartment's owner.

Once they are registered in the census of A Coruña, they will request in the same office the certificate of the census called certificado de empadronamiento, which they need to take to the Foreign Office Department at the Police (C/ Real 53 baixo) along with the following documents:

- 1 passport picture.
- Original and a copy of passport or identity card.
- Copy of the registration at EASD Pablo Picasso.
- Fill out the documents given to them at the Police.

## Health Insurance

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All foreign students should come with an insurance coverage valid for Spain. Those students affiliated to Social Security, should apply for the Health Insurance Card in the Social Security Centres of their country of origin. This card will allow them to use all of the Social Security services and hospitals in Spain when needed, free of charge. In case of serious illness, students can go to the Social Security hospital in A Coruña (Complejo Hospitalario Universitario da Coruña).

For other less serious matters students can go to the Health Centre nearest them or to the "Casa do Mar" in A Coruña. Students not affiliated to Social Security have to bring private insurance coverage. In this case they will have to know which private hospital they can go to, and arrange the payment conditions with their insurance company. For list of private hospitals, please refer to Section – Hospitals in A Coruña (page 46).

Any other insurance, such as coverage against theft or luggage lost, can be helpful.
